## Saint Theresa School – Smart Money Scholarship Program

June 1 through May 31<sup>st</sup>

### Description of Program:

The Smart Money Scholarship Program is a program run by volunteers at Saint Theresa School and Parish. This program supports students that attend Saint Theresa School, Trinity High School, Bishop McDevitt High School and our Religious Education program. The larger the proceeds are from card sales, the larger the fund, therefore more dollars are available to distribute to Scholarship recipients.

### Eligibility/Program Requirements:

1. To be eligible you must participate in the Smart Money Program by purchasing gift cards.
2. You must submit a Smart Money Scholarship Application by the appropriate deadline.
3. Distribution of Funds is contingent upon continued operation of the program by volunteers and the generation of sufficient proceeds to meet the scholarship requests.

### Distribution of Funds:

Notifications of scholarship awards are made in July. Scholarship amounts will appear as a credit on the tuition agreement or statement for St. Theresa families in August. Payment will be made directly to the high schools or to the Religious Education Program for students attending those programs.

### Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ):

**Question:** My child is graduating and will not be attending a Catholic school next year. How does the program work for us?

**Answer:** Families with no remaining siblings will receive your scholarship award credited to your May tuition bill. Your scholarship application will be due April 25<sup>th</sup>.

**Question:** How much do I put down on the amount requested on the Scholarship Application?

**Answer:** Ask for the amount that you feel you need.

**Question:** I have my parents and co-workers buying Smart Money for me. Do they need to fill out a Smart Money Scholarship application?

**Answer:** No. Only the school family should apply.

**Question:** I have an 8<sup>th</sup> grade student who will be going to a Catholic High School. How does that work for Smart Money?

**Answer:** Indicate on your application where the tuition award should be made (check the appropriate box). We will work with you and the appropriate tuition management system at the school.
