- **6th, 7th, 8th** will also need 1 clear plastic "shoebox" style tub with a lid. Measurements are roughly 12"long x 6"wide x 4" tall.
- **8th only:** 1 hardcover book, that is 1-2' thick. This should be a book that is being saved from the trash, or one that you buy from Goodwill for 1.00 or less. The spine

and pages need to be intact. We will be created an altered book throughout the year... A.K.A. cutting, gluing, and painting in the book.
