Attendance Reminders

Students are considered tardy if they are not in their classrooms by 8:15 a.m. Please have a valid parent note for the tardy, otherwise this is considered an unexcused tardy to school.

Students who have been absent from school need to return with a valid parent note. A note should be presented within three days of returning from an absence in order to be excused. Students who are absent more than three days in a row should return with a doctor's note. You can speak to the nurse if you have any questions or concerns.
