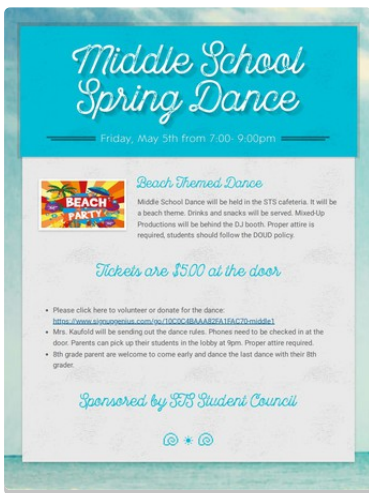
Checks should be made out to St Theresa School, cash is also accepted. Wristbands and tickets will be given to the student on April 27, 2023.
